#### Seneschal's Report - HL Brigitte die Arrogante

We now have a background check procedure that An Tir will be implementing for Canadian SCA members that will be warranted Youth Armoured Combat Marshals, youth mentors, or Family Activity Co-ordinators. Background check is being run by a third party who will handle all confidentiality. If a person gets a deferred status, there will be a follow-up step done to get more information. Currently all the seneschal needs from those working with youth is what you are doing (to determine whether it falls under the criteria that needs the background checks), your legal name, and your membership number.

Kingdom wants all events listed in the Crier. There is a Kingdom Law that states that for awards to be official, they must be read out at an event listed in the Crier. In the past it has been interpreted that since Baronial or Shire awards have no effect on the order of precedence, they were never considered official awards to begin with and thus not affected by this law. The law is now being interpreted to mean all awards at any level.

We are still waiting for feedback from Kingdom over the appointment of the Family Activities Coordinator. We have an application in but since this office is vacant at the Principality level, everything needs to go to Kingdom officer.

We are still looking for a permanent Council location. We are committed to having it on the fourth Wednesday every month.
