***There is an update to current practices:

Practices:

<u>Sunday Practices</u>: For this season, the Sunday practices will be our main/primary practice, with the Thursday one being our optional, secondary practice as both equipment and Sr. Marshals are available. Ongoing on the Sundays from about 12pm - 5pm with the winter/spring daylight hours. Attendance is currently sitting around 10-13 people per practice. We have had some new arrivals to our practices, and anticipate more in the coming weeks.

Thursday Practices: ***As of March 22, we do not currently have an official start date to this practice. As my deputy for Thursday has stepped down, and with the primary focus being on the Sunday practice, there is a challenge in having our butts available at the Burnaby range on a weekly basis and still be available for the Sunday practice. I have created a spreadsheet to track our supplies and scribal needs going forward and shared this with the Baron and Baroness. Scrolls for Canterbury faire have been assigned and are being worked on. Scrolls for May Champions have also been assigned. I will be receiving a number of finished charters at Canterbury Faire. I have charter blanks to hand out and the masters. I am still in the process of doing an inventory of the scribal library and backlogged scrolls that we still have not been able to connect with their recipients. The previous scribe made a major push to find the owners of many of these scrolls but unfortunately we still have quite a few. We may need to make a deadline for finding the owners and a plan for what to do with them should the owners be unfindable. I have begun making connections and a list of willing scribes in the area and hope to begin handing out charters and more scroll assignments soon.

Two 18"x22" black cushions with white abstract patterning. Top of cushions would be the patterned upholstery fabric, bottom would be black denim or duck cloth, with a zipper so the cover can be removed for washing.

I expect to need no more than a month to finish these.

Throne Baronial Arms Bid Agnes Cresewyke

This is my terribly casual bid/proposal for doing the Baronial Arms on the new chairs. Please forgive the tone, it has been a hectic couple of weeks.

I have a lot of artist quality acrylic paints, I would be varnishing over top of the actual acrylic paint as it needs to be durable enough to leant on for a few years. They will be painted directly onto the chair so there would be no hard edges or discomfort to lean against. I have already talked with His Excellency about what the design should look like and where on the backs it would be to get an idea of what they really wanted to see. I can check in at every step of the project via internet messaging with images of progress and asking for feedback.

My skills as an artist can be seen in the pictures I have attached to this email. I have over 3 decades of art training and experience along with three years of formal college training. I have painted on a variety of surfaces and I would want to test paint to make sure of no chemical conflicts in the materials. The art attached, the first one is gouache on paper with gold leaf. A Pelican scroll. In reality much smaller than this image. This shows detail work. The second image is of the shield I painted for Sgt Cyneric Bearson. This shows painting on wooden surfaces and a level of detail at that size. The third image is of the shield I painted for Yeoman Brynmor's shield. His was a challenge and an experiment that turned out well. The trial and error of the finishing was a learning experience. Acrylic medium to seal it flattened out the black so I had to repaint over it for more detail and then seal it with the varnish instead. Showed more depth.

The costs incurred for the chairs would be \$75 each for a total of \$150. I would need the parts to be painted for a minimum of two weeks, maximum of three. I know this would be difficult to manage with all the events that are upcoming this summer but I am hoping to be able to work around that. I do not drive. And that is a big hangup for getting the chair parts to and from where they need to be. Thank you for your consideration and opportunity to serve my Barony. YIS
