Thrown Weapons - Archos Elora

Current inventory consists of 3 throwing axes, 2 spare handles, 6 throwing knives (2 with sheaths were donated by HL Tewl Gover of Tir Bannog, & 2 were donated by Sergeant Miles), 1 spear (donated by HL Tewl Gover of Tir Bannog), 3 hard target stands, 3 hard target rounds. I request the reinstatement of the \$75 budget per year for the office as the stands are in need of repair due to their extensive use, and multiple handles have been broken over the years.

At this time I would like to thank the Baron and Baroness, and Council for all their support over these past years when I asked to form a Thrown Weapons office and have run gleefully with it. At this time I would like to request the posting of applications to hand over the mantle to another.

Tournament of Armies

Thrown Weapons - 2 senior and 3 junior marshals worked together to teach and run the thrown weapons range. There was one stand that was damaged (appropriate photo taken of the Tanist to memorialize his victory) but there were no injuries.

Combat archery - 1 armour failure during a scenario, but otherwise no injuries or incidences to report.

Youth Armoured Combat - Lady Sibhaidh

No practices or tournaments this month.

Was just informed that the Locker has a bin with things in it labelled for YAC. I will be attempting to coordinate to acquire said bin to condense what I have received as donations to Minor Key and decide what is good, what is not and create a FULL inventory of current Minor Key for the Chatelaine. I had been set on requesting a purchasing budget for a bin/bag for Minor Key, however, I will now wait to see what we already have. As I understand it, Sir Kheron has ordered some Youth Rattan and we may, as a Barony purchase what we like of it with the approved \$50 funds.

There is to be a Youth Champion Tourney at Trials.

I have put the announcement out that I am looking for a replacement to head YAC in our Barony. While I intend to stay active as a Sr. Marshal, it would be good to get the rest of the Barony and fighters involved, especially our Sergeantry, present and past.

I would like to request a new bid for 2-3 shields for our Minor Key. 20", 22" and 24" wide rounds matching the YAC rule requirements. Understanding of those requirements (closed foam padding and such) is a requirement.

The Barony held the event Tournament of Armies during the weekend of August 4-7, a few things happened there. A class for Heraldic Submissions was given by Baroness Caitrina Inghean Aindriasa. My predecessor, Cáemgen mac Garbith ui Andrais, officially stepped down and I had water splashed over me. Cáemgen mac Garbith ui Andrais heralded the event's opening court and started the closing court, I completed the final court business. Accidents and Injuries

There was one incident on the warfield (to be reported by MIC Sir Griffin). Viscountess Lishinia hurt her knee and had to go to the hospital.

One incident of a badly injured ankle where Lady Angharad also went to the hospital. Lady Angharad rolled her ankle while walking over the unlevel ground. Her ankle has been injured before and is weak as a result. She returned to the site later in the day.

Biffie Program

The Buy-A-Biffie program had 4 groups participate and all 4 groups were very happy with the program and would do it again. Unfortunately, due to a misunderstanding with the biffie vendor (Valley Tank), a small cost was borne by the Barony for the pumping of the private units during the event. The invoicing from the vendor was a mess so the guesstimate for what it cost the Barony for the private units was about \$44 per unit (total \$176).

Merchant Fees

The Event Team charged an optional merchant fee. When we first published that no merchant fee would be charged, some vendors contacted the Merchant Coordinator to complain. If they weren't charged a fee to sell their wares, they couldn't claim the expenses to get to the event as a business expense. As such, we made the merchant fee optional and offered receipts if needed. One vendor opted to pay the fee but didn't request a receipt. A total of 12 merchants attended the event.

Site Logistics

The site was too large and if this location is used in the future, a different layout would be considered. A possible configuration would be to encourage camping in the wooded areas and move the warfield to where camping was held. Other ideas tossed around included having a war wagon for moving armor between the warfield and camp areas since the distance is large.

Event components

Thrown weapons

After the event started, this was changed to having a time limit and set amount of coins to be earned in that time. This worked really well. Was a set amount per throwing scenario then a percentage was awarded to the warlord. This carried over into Archery and Equestrian too.

<u>Equestrian</u>

- Do more progresses heralded in advance
- Mounted town crier next time would be excellent
- No one signed up for Honey Pot (too dang hot)
- Give kids a chance to ride or pet ponies (Age 6 and over)
- The Get 'em Young challenge was VERY popular.
- Perhaps a YAFA class to do grooming next time
- Old hand, new rider also quite popular
- It was hard to track coins without physical coins
- Forage to Feed was very tough logistically but the most fun to watch. It was a true challenge of skill.

- Next time need 2 people to run equestrian component. One person not enough.
- Need better and bigger signage (no touchy the ponies please). Will be getting banners made.
- Next time use the warm arena more maybe.

<u>A&S</u>

Participation in the challenges was very, very good!

<u>Bardic</u>

Coin challenge was okay but not great. Maybe give people 3 coins to give out and do 3 faciliated rounds of bardic.

Really want to do a Bardic Squadron again instead. One group performance with a time limit of 5 minutes. Do Saturday night. If one army is eliminated before then, auction off the squadron before performance. An army could then potentially have 2 squadrons competing to get the Bardic Boon then. Exciting!

<u>Boons</u>

- Equestrian was good.
- Archery was good but needs to be awarded sooner next time. Also, couldn't figure out who had it since Archery MIC got hurt (Lady Anghard).
- Rapier Boon didn't work at all. Didn't work with only 4 armies. Need to completely redesign.

Random notes:

- Service coins were underutilized at gate. Hardly any volunteers to assist.
- Time limits on presentations by armies in court.
- Consider auctioning off armies that are eliminated in the tournament rounds instead of doing absorption. Makes the coin more important!
- YAC tourney didn't go due to failed armor inspections.
- In future, no coin for retinue. Didn't work and screwed up where service was truly needed (eg. at gate)
- Try to avoid running rapier and heavy at the same time
