New Equestrian Waiver - we will need to add these to our webpage

These new forms are a combination of the the equestrian waiver and the non-member event waiver, so that now there is only ONE waiver that adults need to sign at equestrian events.

Non-equestrian events will continue to function with the regular waivers as they have in the past, but equestrian events will no longer require non-members to sign 2 waivers. Attendees at equestrian events will fill out the gate sheet, and ALL attendees will sign the one equestrian waiver.

Financial Results 2017

On income of \$40433.29 and expenses of \$35288.30, we have a net gain of \$5144.99 for 2017. These are unofficial numbers until after the fourth quarter reporting is completed.

- Receivables carried forward: \$375
 - \$50 Thursday practice float (to be carried over to 2018)
 - \$175 general supplies (to be solved shortly)
 - \$150 deposit to City of Maple Ridge for The Trials 2018
- The prepaid expenses for the Public Storage were used up at the end of December, giving us the month of January 2018 for free.

Equestrian – Her Ladyship Briana nic h'Eusaidh

There were no practices or events with equestrian participation since November council.

There were four Lions Gate members at the equestrian meeting at Twelfth Night, and some good networking occurred there. It is always good to reconnect with the participants and officers from other parts of the Kingdom.

In administrative news, there have been changes to main gate waivers for equestrian events, which removes a step in sign-ins at any event where the equestrian insurance has been activated, which makes gate more streamlined for all attendees. There have also been changes to the authorisation paperwork, and I am working to update all authorisations currently on file. I will be delivering the updated authorisations to the secretary at Ursulmas, so they will be updated in the database shortly thereafter.

According to the forms I have on file, Lions Gate has had 52 authorised riders and ground crew participate at events and practices in the last 4 years. We are working on driving authorisations for several individuals, other special authorisations for mounted combat and crest combat, and junior marshal authorisations for eight. We will very likely see a minimum of another four senior equestrian marshals made this year, as experienced equestrians become familiar with the Kingdom expectations for the position. We remain the only branch equestrian program that has a perfect safety record, and we endeavour to see that this remains the standard for Lions Gate and for Tir Righ, as equestrian expands into the rest of the Principality.

We are still awaiting confirmation of a signed contract and activation of the equestrian insurance for the dates requested for Practices (Feb 11, Mar 18, Apr 22, June 24, July 15, Aug 19, Oct 7, Oct 28, Nov 18, Dec 9). Due to not having location or insurance confirmed, I was unable to submit these practice dates to the Kingdom Equestrian Officer's calendar. As soon as it is in place, we are champing at the bit to get moving on our mounted gaming and skills development.

This looks to be a busy year for our growing aspect of historical recreation. There will be equestrian representation at our annual demo at Langley Fundamental School in February. We have been asked to supply some equestrian equipment to the Shire of Thornwood for their Sir Eddie's Memorial Tourney event, May 4-6, and our hosting of SeaLion War at Island 22 enables us to have equestrian activities at this event as well. Champions Tourney and TOA's sites are yet to be decided, but if equestrian is possible

there, I will offer my services as soon as the locations are decided and if the option exists. It has proven a popular and expansive addition to Lions Gate's hallmark event, so I am hopeful that it will be in the plan for this year as well. As soon as a bid for Trials is approved, we will know how Eq will function for that event as well.

In addition, there is the excellent potential for Equestrian activities to be included in May Crown, to be hosted by Ramsgaard. The KEO is excited about the possibility and will be the EMiC, with support from his Pricipality deputy. If this ends up a go, I'd like permission to offer Lions Gate's Equestrian equipment for the event, as none of the branches more local to the site have equestrian functionality as of yet.
