SENESCHAL'S REPORT - Archos Morweena

Facebook - A reminder that our web page is our official internet presence, not Facebook. Facebook is a handy tool, but as it is a public social media platform where people may or may not connect or may not be in our group, the web page and email list are where all official announcements are made.

Contacting Sites - FRVD and Island 22 have been sent a list of "approved contacts" for Sealion and TOA to try and minimize the issue we have been having with a person from the Island contacting them directly.

Just a reminder – you must work with the event team. If you have an issue dealing with the event team, please speak to me or their Excellencies – *never* the site. When a contract is in place, the Barony is responsible for all activities at an event.

Meetings - Tried to book the Safeway meeting room for April 25 (today) and May 23, but it was already booked by another group – I think it's the group we kicked out last month, so we will be here at VanCity for that date.

June - moved to the third week as requested, to June 20. Safeway is available and I have booked it for 7:30 to 9:30 pm.

Insurance – Head office was late processing Sealion insurance, but it is done now. Will need to order insurance for June Champions now that we FINALLY have the contract (I need to obtain proof of being a signatory to hand in with the contract) and TOA.

This will be \$50 US for Champions and \$100 US for TOA. I would appreciate an advance of \$150 to pay for these.

I spoke to the principality seneschal about a deposit secured credit card – that is to say a credit card that has a "limit" based on a prepayment to be used for ordering insurance. As long as the amount is low (\$200 as this is our max spending without council approval as per our finance policy) she thought it was a good idea to remove the need to have the seneschal pay for insurance and get reimbursed. Right now, between practices and events, this is around \$700 US per year.

Can our exchequer look into this? Can our bank issue such a card? It is not a "credit" card as there is no credit attached, just a balance held by prepayment.

NOTE – Vote for \$150 advance was moved, seconded and approved by council.

Customary updates - Morweena

Their Excellencies have sent me the sections that are their domain and returned my edited sections. Once we have a final version it will be presented to council at a special meeting to be scheduled but not in May.

Lions Gate Pavilion - Baron / Brynia

Greetings. Having put the pieces together, we're going to need council's permission before proceeding.

The pavilion from Panther Primitives is \$1495 USD, or \$1770 with fire-retardant added. I think we should go with the second option.

Adding the taller walls (as high as our previous) is an additional \$116.

The complete "set up" package (poles, ropes, stakes) is \$835, plus an additional \$40 due to the taller walls.

This comes to \$2,761 USD. West Virginia sales tax brings this to \$2,926.70 USD Current exchange makes this approx. \$3,534.10

Duties at the border at 18% would add \$636.13, bringing it to a total of \$4,170.21

The special fund for the pavilion currently sits at \$3,672.90, leaving a shortfall of \$497.31.

I ask council to consider topping up the total cost from general funds.

- Can likely remove duty costs
- Assume up to \$400 shipping

Motion to spend up to \$400 USD for shipping - approved Motion to move up to \$500 CA from general funds to pavilion fund – approved Motion to spend up to \$650 CA for duty, if required – approved Motion to advance amount to Mark Hood - approved

Polling: Thursday, May 24 7:30 pm to 9:30 pm (Thursday rapier practice) Method of Polling: in person ballot

Absentee ballots will be available and mailed to crown or representative but must be requested by email no later than May 21. Only current PAID members will be given a ballot - what a GREAT time to renew!

Only paid SCA members are eligible to receive a polling form. Those who reside within the boundaries of the Barony will receive their forms at the in-person polling. Officers, Sergeants, Courtiers, Gallants, Yeomen, and Lancers who live outside the area code range of the branch, and are members, will be included in the polling.

Those that cannot attend the in-person polling will have the opportunity to mail their ballot directly to the Crown or Their representative but in-person ballots are preferred.

Other input may be submitted in writing via email, postal mail or in person.

This is a polling only, not a vote, the final decision and appointment of the new Baron and/or Baroness rests solely with the Crown.

All jobs are to be posted, and interested parties should write to their Excellencies and the Seneschal to apply. The outgoing officer may supply a recommendation.
