We took three horses and the Lions Gate equipment to Thornwood for Sir Eddie's Tourney, where we were joined by three others equestrians including the Kingdom Eq Officer. We did two versions of a challenge course, one for accuracy and style, and one for speed.

Due to the hard ground, two of Lions Gate's lances were damaged beyond repair, so they will need to be replaced. I will be purchasing the materials for that in the next few weeks, in order to have them ready for the next equestrian event.

In addition, all I need to authorize for driving is send a video to the KEO to show what I know. As soon as I am authorized, we will be able to have cart and chariot activities at our equestrian events. It will also enable me to authorize others as drivers.

Lions Gate brought two horses and some equipment to May Crown, and helped get five riders authorized for general riding, mounted gaming and mounted archery. It's good for the Barony that Tir Righ's equestrian program is growing.

Sealion War suffered a change of venue due to flooding, and due to a tighter budget and limitations of the site's renovations, the event team has opted not to do equestrian at the War this year.

There has been the addition of equestrian activities to the calendar, with the change in venue of Ducal War, and the new venue may have some lease horses available which will alleviate the

pressure on our mounts for those who would like to ride. We will be working with the Tir Righ Equestrian Officer to make the event a success for our discipline.
