SENESCHAL'S REPORT - Archos Morweena

Customary updates - Morweena

Their Excellencies have sent me the sections that are their domain and returned my edited sections. Delay is 100% ME.

Lions Gate Pavilion - Baron / Brynia

Justin is bringing it up from Ulfgar, to then be picked up from fight practice. Party to set it up and figure it out.

What are the plans for the canvas walls for the old one?

Roof – bags for the current thrones. Uilliam would like to send it out for bids. Morweena suggested if it is being done for free, no bid is required.

From the Chamberlain - I would like to request a portion of the retired pavilion canvas so that we can make pole carrying bags for all the different types of poles that we have in the locker.

For example: Eric poles (bags sized for 8 poles (1 eric per bag), Pavilion poles/beams, Butlery/Privacy Wall poles and rods, Flagging and Anchoring stakes.

Motion for approval for the Chamberlain to use the walls as he sees fit (for utility use). Seconded and approved

Website - Seneschale

Still nothing on the web page for Equestrian, Scribal or A&S (other than happenings at Monday fight practice). This info must be on the web page as our official presence. It is ok to note "check the Lions Gate Facebook page for information on A&S meetings" for example.

If it is not there, it is not covered by our insurance (unless there is a named certificate). For example, if someone gets ill at a cooks meeting, it is on the home owner unless it is on the web page in some fashion.

Wax Seals - Baron

This was tabled from last month. Question was to transfer budget from Scribe to Baron and Baroness. Discussion says a budget line item should be added to Baronial expenses.

Request one-time purchase a standard glue gun (up to \$20), proposal approved.

\$35 as inclusion to Baronial budget for sticks of wax for seals. Proposal approved.

Officer Vacancies

Note that everyone should try and recruit a deputy at least 6 months prior to stepping down to train them in their office. This will help prevent long vacancies in a role. Some of these roles may be filled once the Baronial succession is closed.

All jobs are to be posted and interested parties write to their Excellencies and the Seneschale to apply, and the outgoing officer can supply a recommendation.

I've been thinking on our process. I'd like to see outgoing officers post their role 2-3 months before they are due to step down. The post should have an open date "taking applications" and a close date for those applications; ideally open for 21 days, with the cutoff date 1 week before council for any interviews and discussions.

The new officers can shadow the outgoing for one month before taking over and allowing the outgoing officer to step away.

Archery: Term is actually September, so this should be posted late July

Chatelaine: We have a new chatelaine - Briana nic h'Eusaidh. James recommended for deputy.

Lists: Has posted looking for a deputy/new officer, wants to step down in November

Games: is Garet! (need to get officer change form)

YAC:

Term up in August, requires background check and marshal status. Has been posted. We also need to encourage more YAC marshals as there are only three in the Lions Gate/Lionsdale area.

Bardic and Librarian

There was discussion on these positions, tabled to the Customary update. Note customary says that offices can be vacant, looking to possible retire the Librarian office.

Social Media Policy - Lady Jakemina

- Recommend each group has a Social Media Officer. Could be Webminister if needed.
- Facebook may not be used for initial event announcements. These must be on the website, official e-mail list or kingdom calendar first. Must be published on the kingdom website.
- Each group is required to use an official Facebook page. Encouraged to have a Facebook group.
- Disclaimers required on group and event pages. Standard piece of text will be available.
- Expectations of conduct.
