Morweena will review the contract with Taisce. The equestrian practice is no longer held at Taisce. Moving us around, as long as Taisce isn't violating the contract, shouldn't be an issue, as their primary business is training horses.

Tanikh pointed out that the concerns need to be investigated. We shouldn't discount a concern that's been brought to us. There should be discussion with Kenneth and with the site owner.

Garet stated that if the biffies are in poor working order, then we could always send a strongly worded letter to Taisce.

Unto the Baron and Baroness of Lions Gate Plus the Honourable Seneschale, doth Kenneth of Shaftesbury send greetings,

For months now, there have been several on-going problems at our archery practice facility. I have been just as guilty as others for not bringing this to the attention of council.

While the range is supposed to be free of droppings, this is not always so. We are also supposed to have a porta-potty and, while we do have one, there are many times when it is not regularly attended to, making the archers go to the local Timmies to use the loo. We shouldn't have to keep complaining to the site owner about this.

Several of our archers have stopped coming to practice because of these conditions, and also because of suspected ill treatment of children and animals who are part of the site. I cannot speak for these missing archers, but I can say that I am joining them in being absent.

On the 11th of July Vivien and I arrived, a trip which takes us about an hour, to be told by two young boys that archery would not be in the indoor arena. We went inside to check and the site owner informed that the arena was double booked. This information was not transmitted to any of the archers early enough so that we could make any decisions. At this point, we were informed that James Wolfden was arranging for us to shoot in an outdoor arena. We were also informed that the indoor arena was also double booked for the Sunday practice and that we would be holding it outside. Because we had asked why the indoor archery had been cancelled, the site owner asked how we had found out. We said that the young boys had told us, and we turned and left. While we were walking away, the site owner started yelling at the young boys. By this point I was grinding my teeth and Vivien was not a happy person, either.

At that point, I made the decision that I would not be going back to Taisce Stables, and I have informed the archers of my decision. Now I would like to see the barony search for a more suitable place for our archery, as the current location is no longer a place that I can attend, in good conscience.
