The break was not a result of poor technique, but what some fighters present (myself included) believed to be a heat-treating flaw in the manufacture of the blade. Mitchel has said he will seek out a replacement blade for free, as the sword was a couple weeks old and had only been used a couple of times (two practices, I believe).
