New Business:

Calendar Fallout

An issue came up with our Open Doors Demo conflicting with the Antioch event. This is similar to last year when the Antioch demo conflicted with the Principality Heraldic Symposium. While demos (and other level 3 events) may be set up well in advance, they are not recorded on the Kingdom calendar. When an event steward is looking at the dates, they will not see the demo and conflict can occur. Typically, this is an issue for neighbouring branches where events draw from both branches.

Working with the senechals of Lions Gate, Lionsdale, and Seagirt, they have decided to create a google calendar that will include all the events regardless of level. This does not replace the official Kingdom calendar. It is just for planning purposes.

AT War

The Principality has set the date for the Avacal/ Tir Righ War for the August long weekend. This is to take advantage of an opportunity presented to it.

The village of Nakusp used to have a music festival. They shut down the music festival and have been looking at an event to replace it. They approached the SCA about doing a Ren Faire and we explained that isn't what we do and then explained what our events are like. They felt that was great with an added demo in it.

They will be providing the land for free for a week long event with a public demo on the second weekend. The demo would run 9-5 and be adjoined but separated from the event. The planned layout would be

The cost of the event is expected to stay at the rate for most Principality events (\$20). Profit from the event will be split in a manner to allow branches to share in the profits based on the branches volunteering to run/assist in various areas. 50% of the profit would be split between the two principalities and 50% would be split between teams doing the work of the event.

Coronet Business

The Baroness was pleased to announce that she will be submitting a new award name to the College of Heralds.

Baron Devon and Baroness Aurora created the Lion's Mark during their reign for outstanding artisans. The award was not passed. They renamed the award to the Lion's Pinion but this was still not passed.

The award was not given out under Baron Griffin and Baroness Caitrin although they did recognize many artisans using the Lions Claw, the Baronial Award for long time service. Baron James and Baroness Margaret chose to recognize artisans via the Baronial Warrant which did not require passage through the heralds.

Baron Uilliam and Baroness Caitrina chose to bring back the award with a new name that could be registered. Baron Devon's real name was Lance Bailey. Baroness Aurora's real name was Dawn Silver. Baroness Caitrina wants to honour them with the name. While there was an initial problem in getting the name registered, it was due to a conflict and permission was given for us to conflict.
