

Seneschal Scribbles

Wow. What a difference a month makes, no?

Last time we spoke, I mentioned several openings within the ranks of Baronial officers. Specifically those of Chirurgeon and Waterbearer. We'll start with the established, known and documented. Chirurgeon: I should have looked in the Rule Book. That's my job, when it comes down to it, right? The day after council, the Honourable Lord James Wolfden found the appropriate section in SCA documentation. From the Corporate Policy of the SCA:

"Section IX. Policy on First Aid at Events
"While organized first aid services are desirable at
events, the Society and its branches may not be
placed in the position of promising to provide these
services. Therefore, while branches are encouraged
to have qualified volunteer first aid personnel
available, they are specifically prohibited from
requiring the presence of a medical officer at events,
and from in any way implying that the Society's
sponsorship of an event depends upon the presence
of organized first aid services."

So, we as a branch of the SCA are not *required* to have a Baronial Chirurgeon, nor are we mandated to have a Chirurgeon on-site during any event or demo or bake-sale or anything else we do. There is also no part of Corpora, the Corporate Policies, Kingdom or Principality law that <u>forbids</u> a Chirurgeonate. In no way is the Chirurgeonate dismantled, banned or otherwise done-away-with.

For anyone present at last month's Council meeting, I must admit to being misguided on the "mandatory" aspects of a Chirurgeon. It's not an office or position we "have to" have, but it is a great idea for a branch the size of ours.

On the subject of Waterbearers:

By now many of you have heard or read of the controversy regarding the position of Waterbearer. If you've missed it, here it is in a nutshell (taken from the Corpora revision post): The President of the SCA was asked to have a look at the various laws of states and countries related to waterbearing as an organized and official activity of the SCA. It was determined that the best way to do this would be to make waterbearing unofficial and unsanctioned by the SCA, Inc. The only other option would be to regulate waterbearing, and to regulate it such that it follows the various food safety codes of the various states and countries the SCA participates in. This would be unwieldy, impractical and expensive for the SCA to do. Further, it is likely that waterbearers

would not be able to continue to serve fighters using any of the current methods of waterbearing. The wording of the proposed change to Corpora states:

"The activity of providing beverages to combatants and spectators at SCA Combat activities is not regulated, warranted, organized, controlled, or sanctioned by the SCA, Inc. or any affiliate or subsidiary entity. All warrants, authorizations, or other formal recognition of this activity are by publication of this change revoked. This document does not either address or restrict such volunteer activity or the methods by which it occurs."

I don't wish to stir the emotional pot again, since there are strong feelings on both sides of this issue. It is my belief that this is not only a reasonable proposal, it's the only way we'd get to keep performing the job. In a world full of frivolous litigation and excessive judicial awards – albeit mostly south of the border – the SCA is allowing us to continue to do exactly what we were doing before, but without an Office. They're leaving it to us to determine which method works best within our laws.

It should also be pointed out that this is a proposal. The Directors have requested comments from the membership regarding this proposed revision, no later than October 1st, 2008.
