

The Baron's Column



There has been a great deal of discussion lately about war archery and heavy helmet requirements. Recently there have been a number of incidents where war archery blunts have penetrated the eye slots of helms. There as yet have been no major injuries, but in that we have



The current ABC's state the distance between bars can be no greater then 1 inch. That has not changed, despite what some people think. I heard a lot of cries of "But it passed before!" at Clinton. What has changed is that now marshals will be following the letter of the law and any helms that do not pass will be failed. In most cases all that would be required to fix it will be a little hammering, though some helms may require a more radical refit.

It would probably be a good idea to check your helms before you go to an event and get failed there, simply find a 1 inch dowel and try and pass it through your bars, if it goes through you fail if not you're good to go. Of course you should probably do this on a regular basis as bars do bend with use.

Another change that has come from all of this is that all combat archery blunts must now be 1½ inch in diameter (was 1¼) with no more than 1 inch of padding on the tip. If your arrows or bolts do not meet this specification they will fail.

SENESCHAL SCRIBBLES

● ou know, I've been going through some old issues of the North Wind recently. Particularly, I've been re-reading the writings of Seneschal/es of the past with a viewpoint I hadn't had previously. And you know something? It all sounds too familiar; "HELP!"

There are still a few officer positions vacant, and in a Barony the size of ours, I find this baffling. Is it that the general populace fell they can't do the job, or don't have the expertise needed? Is everyone waiting for someone else to fill it? Are you hoping you'll be asked?

One of the discussions we'll be having over the next few months involves imposing a mandatory two-year term of office for Baronial Officers. This isn't designed to be a way of getting rid of people who've been doing a job for years and years, but a way of getting new people **thinking** about taking on an office. If an office isn't vacant, you seldom think about taking it on. But if the office will be open for applications in a couple of months – even if the current officer is doing a great job – maybe you'll think about stepping up. In discussions with the Principality Seneschale, it's come to light that we already have such limits in place, we just seldom follow them.

\$\infty\$, in accordance with Kingdom and Principality Law, all officers serving the Barony of Lions Gate are subject to two-year terms of office. Most of our officers are "warranted", meaning their Principality (or sometimes Kingdom) superior officer has signed the papers submitted, saying that they agree with the Barony's choice of officer, and

making them "official". The paperwork also contains a list of signatures of other Baronial officers, agreeing to work with the new officer. A couple of months prior to the end of the two-year term, the populace is invited to apply for the upcoming position. Now, we're not as absolute when it comes to extensions as the Kingdom and Principality officers are, mostly because of our population. If nobody else applies for a position for years, we can easily keep submitting one-year extensions until someone else steps up or the current officer keels over dead. I'd really rather not get to that point.

So watch for openings and notifications! Offer to help any office you might be interested in. Maybe even just offer to be a deputy with no aspirations of taking the office on. For anyone interesting in getting into serving the Barony, the newest vacant office is Gold Key. This is the office that provides basic loaner garb to newcomers at events. This is a great starting point for anyone, particularly new members. We still are looking for Heralds, the Captain of the Baronial Watch, Chirurgeon, and Waterbearer.

And finally, because I've been asked and corrected regarding this several times already; the office I currently hold is titled "Seneschal" if held by a man, and "Seneschale" if held by a woman.

Kingdom Bardic Championship 27th September, 2008




Kingdom Bardic Championship will be upon us before we know it. The date is September 26, 27 and 28, in the beautiful Barony of Lions Gate
