SENESCHAL'S REPORT - Archos Morweena

Premiere Events

Morweena attended Seneschals' meeting.

November 21, 2018

Right now, the policy is that each branch gets one event that no one else in Tir Righ may conflict with. This was set up by Duke Ieugn and Duchess Gweneth when they were last Prince and Princess. The intent is to allow the coronets to travel to each branch at least once.

The two busiest branches - us and Seagirt were the most impacted by this as we had to reschedule one event that had a long-standing date. I'm not 100% sure if this policy will continue past 2019

Right now, all our 2019 events are filed and ready; 2020 will be settled in the next few months after consultation with our new B&B – May move things around @ end of year if we need to.

Spending and Finance Policy

This came up last meeting due to some unapproved expenses

This isn't intended to beat a dead horse or single out an incident. It's just that money is one of the areas we MUST be as transparent as possible with

- as per our finance policy all expenses should be pre-approved by council.

"Whenever possible, all expenditures of Lions Gate funds must be pre-approved by Council of Lions Gate. "

There are ways to approve expenses that are needed either before a meeting or in an emergency

"If there is no regularly scheduled Lions Gate Council Meeting occurring before the expenditure is required, then the criteria outlined in Table B-1 must be met. In addition, a full accounting (including receipts and signed authorizations) must be presented at the next scheduled Lions Gate Council Meeting. In exceptional situations, when the Baron and/or Baroness, Seneschal, and Exchequer are in agreement, funds may be dispersed with the intent of presenting a full accounting to Council at the next Lions Gate Meeting. See Table B-1 for the decision criteria."

Table B-1: Outline of criteria for approving expenses.

Amount	Approval Needed
less than \$50.00	Oral approval of the Baron, Baroness and the Seneschal (in consultation with the Exchequer)
less than \$100.00	Written approval of the Baron, Baroness and the Seneschal (in consultation with the Exchequer)
less than \$200.00	Written approval of the Baron, Baroness, the Seneschal and Exchequer
\$200.00 or greater	Must be pre-approved by the Financial Committee and Lions Gate Council (included in minutes)

At no point should we have people coming to council with expenses that are not approved either by council or the Finance committee in advance - we are not that hard to get a hold of if something like the V-Con chatelaine expenses pop up.

We hold other people's money and the SCA holds us to strict finance policies because of some MAJOR issues and possibility for abuse so we do need to adhere to this policy.

That said the requested expenses reimbursement is on the agenda

Contracts

Just a reminder to check the contracts - things like site access times, exclusive catering clauses, liquor license requirements, have to be respected or we may be facing additional charges after the event.

Also a remind that only the Seneschal is empowered by the SCA Inc. as the signing authority - if something needs to be changed on a signed contract I have to be involved. Sometimes things can be changed - sometimes they cannot. Using Cloverdale as an example, access before 8 am costs an extra \$100 per hour. Also the named insurance requires start times - if someone is injured before the insurance starts we have an issue.

All practice contracts come due in January; does heavy want to continue at Westwinds? Yes. Thrown weapons and archery want to stay in Taisce Stables; equestrian considering moving practice.

It is a low pressure environment for new folk to meet and interact with more experienced members of our group, so please feel free to attend! These are held at my place of residence in Cloverdale, and there are dogs and a cat to consider, if you would like to come!

I am investigating the possibility of renting community rooms at Surrey Public Library. They have several available, ranging in price from \$10 an hour to \$45 an hour, and in addition, I am investigating applying for a public partnership with SPL to get the use of the rooms for free and to run the Newcomer Nights as a public event type of thing. Flyers: I will be drafting up some flyers for the public libraries and other community centres, once I have dates and details for next season's Newcomer Nights and Newcomer focussed practices.

Demo Kit: I am refining the material I have on hand and packing it into totes for easy/modular storage and transport. Once I have the kits assembled, I will take pictures of various configurations to include in the kits to give ideas of how to set things up for various kinds of demos. So, there was an event this last weekend, a couple of things happened there. I would like to start off with my thanks to Garet for assisting with court heralding and the others that performed town crier. We also have 2 new Lion's Claws, Fergus and Mauley, much deserved and congratulations. Nergui presented the Baroness an application to join the Sargentry, and was accepted. We also have 2 new champions: Heavy Champion of Lions Gate Lord Oswell and new Games Champion of Lions Gate is Élaïne. And finally, after giving many thanks and a few personal tokens, Their Excellencies Uilliam and Caitrina stepped down, Cyneric and Arianna stepped up. The champions, officers, Courtiers and Sargentry were all transitioned over afterward.

There has also been a few inquiries for assistance in developing heraldic submission, this will be followed up in the next few weeks.

Minister of Stables - Brynia Oct 2018- Oct 2020

Practices in November currently averaging 7-8 fighters each week, both heavy and rapier/cut & thrust.

Currently averaging 2 knights and 2 MoD's per Monday night practice.

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We had a tourney at Baroness' Inspiration on Nov 17th. There were 35 unbelted fighters with an additional 9-10 knights.

Tourney was won by Brynmor, again. As the member of the sergeantry who placed the highest in the tournament Brynmor once again is the holder of the Boar Spear for the next year.

No injuries were reported.

I currently don't have access to the master of stables e-mail, I'm hoping we can fix that after council on Wednesday.

Archery James Wolfdon Sept 2018-Sept 2020

Sunday Archery practices continue but we have stopped the Thursday Night Practice because of the cold, dark, and lower attendance. At Baroness' Inspirational Tourney, I handed out archer's tassels to those archers that have received a new ranking this season. I also handed out the most improved male archer to Gunnar the Wanderer, most improved female archer to Sheryl Shelden (not present at the event), and the Golden Bolt to Thorey for most improved crossbow archer. The Golden Bolt was originally given for the highest score with a crossbow but, over time, consistent winner David of Tiriane made a request that it be given out to the most improved crossbow archer. I received the Golden Bolt two years ago but it was not handed out last year. Instead, Delwyn tasked me with seeing what I could do to increase the number of crossbow shooters this year. We went from two shooters in 2017 to six shooters in 2018. I may want to look, with input from the Baron and Baroness, at possibly changing the purpose of the Golden Bolt again.

There were no archers that made the Company of Lions Gate Archers this year. The original purpose of the Company was to encourage archers to shoot Royal Rounds in categories other than Open in the hopes of winning more Top Ten medallions for Lions Gate. It was changed at one point to put a greater emphasis on period archery. An archer has to requalify every year for the company so we will see a big push with a large number of archers meeting the requirements and then followed by just one or two archers in the next year. It requires a lot of variety and often the archers will want to concentrate on a specific bow type in the year following. I will be talking with the archers of Lions Gate about what changes they would like to see to the Company and bringing them forward to Their Excellencies.

I will be looking at buying archery netting. There is a special archery fund which was originally setup with that as the intention. Boorman's has a 50 foot length of used netting at a very good price (\$300) but 50 feet is more than we need and storage may be an issue. As well, while I have been told it "lightly used" it is still a used net and we have a very heavily used net. A new net 10'x10' would likely run us around \$200 plus shipping but I am still looking at options. The An Tir Book of Target does not consider archery netting a permanent backstop allowing a reduction in the safety zones. It is simply

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considered a convenience for the archers to not have go as far to find their arrows. However, many parks that we rent from do require netting as a safety measure.
