Greetings Lions Gate. Recently, Their Excellencies and I sat down to go over the calendar for the coming year, AS 43. (I'll provide a list for the year below) While everything looks great so far, there are a couple of changes to traditional Lions Gate events that I'd like to bring to your attention. Primarily, we've switched the months in which we hold Baroness' Tourney, and Baronial Banquet.

Beginning this year, Baroness' Tourney will be held in mid-November, while Baronial Banquet will take place in early-to-mid-December. Specifically this year, Baroness' on November 15th, and Banquet on December 6th.

While we're on this subject, we need autocrats for both of these events, and a head cook for Baronial Banquet. Thinking about it? There are plenty of people and resources to help you out, you have but to ask.

* Note that we have decided to separate the Heavy and Archery Defenders' Tournaments, moving Archery later into the season. More information on these events will be forthcoming through the year.

Next up, there are currently several Baronial Officer positions vacant. Your Barony needs you! Three in particular are fairly important positions, but have various skill requirements.

Chirurgion: This is the tough one. Chirurgions (usually pronounced "ki-ur-juhns") are the volunteer first-aid responders and organizers of the SCA. There are very specific requirements to be a Chirurgion, and more to be the Chirurgion-In-Charge of an event or of a branch. These can be found in a more detailed form on the Kingdom website, but two important requirements are that you possess a current first-aid certificate (or acceptable alternative), and that you possess a current CPR certification. For more info on the job – and the people involved – have a look at <http://antir.chirurgeonguild.org/articles.php>.

Sable Loat Pursuivant (Herald): The requirements for this job are nowhere near as stringent as Chirurgion, but does require some specific skills. The Sable Loat is responsible for ensuring that heraldry happens within the Barony, so you should be at least passingly familiar with heraldry and the workings of the College of Arms. There are a good number of heralds and past Sable Loats around who – due to other commitments – cannot take the office, but are willing and able to help and support you in the job. The Sable Loat is **not** specifically the voice behind the thrones, or the guy out on the tourney field, or the women sitting at the consulting table; he is the one organizing all the others, and ensuring Things Happen. Waterbearer: In the past, we've tried going without this office. Often the Marshal-In-Charge of an event ensures that water is available, but that isn't always the case. This is an important position, particularly as the summer months approach. The Baronial Waterbearer is responsible for ensuring that someone is in charge of the Waterbearers at an event, and that the equipment is in good order and available. While not required, the Waterbearer should have transportation or at least be able to arrange transport of the various water jugs and bottles. This is a great job to take on if you want to help out, but don't know where to start. Start here!

Please contact the Chronicler if you have super old (or just old, or even new, we need them all!) issues to contribute.

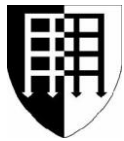
Also, we are still (and always!) looking for content to fill these pages. I know that many of you

Points of interest:

1. As per **His Majesty, the King of An Tir:**

For the remainder of this Reign the following Combat Rule must be obeyed:

All knee-lines must be marked in some fashion. If you wear your armour visible, that is fine, but if you wear pants over your leg armour, you must put some sort of marking designating where a legal blow is and where a legal blow is not. The manner of that marking is left to you. It doesn't have to be flaming orange tape you can see from space, but it needs to be obvious to your opponent from a few feet away.

2. In February, the **Shire of Eisenmarche and the Shire of Lionsdale, and the Barony of Lions Gate** announced that they had joined together to create a new Farspeaker. (Yes - one directory to bind them all!)



The original dates were collection up to March 31st, with publication set for April 30th. Given that there were less than 70 entries received, the branch seneschals agrees to extend the deadlines.

Accordingly, we will be collecting entries until June 15th, and publishing June 30th. Lionsdale's collection is being done by Sebastian de Sandoval, HL Rhiannon is collecting for Eisenmarche, and I'm collecting for Lions Gate.
