**REMINDER: Officer Reports are requested by Monday evening the week of council. This allows me time to follow up with any absent reports.**

**\*Event Teams:\***

So, there's a new process. I've copied it below, but if you're on an event team and not sure what to do, reach out and we will help you get going.

The new process:

- Event is added to the Calendar. (We CAN NOT have an event on FB before it is added to the Calendar that violates the Society SM Policy.)
- Branch Pages will make the Event page. This can be the Social Media Officer, if the Branch has one, or the Seneschal. (Make sure it is made through the PAGE and not the Discussion Group)
- Name of the Event should be "Event Name - Branch Name"
- I recommend that the full information be on the Calendar. (i.e. the EIF has been submitted with site location and times so that all that information can be correct. The Event pages will allow the Site Address to be a place holder such as "Barony of Blah Blah" but those are often forgotten and people cannot use them for finding the actual site.)
- In the Event Information the following disclaimer should be posted :  
  
"This event is held and managed by (region/branch name), a branch of the Society for Creative Anachronism, Inc. and is considered the official presence of this group here. Questions regarding its content should be directed to (event steward's email) or to socialmedia@antir.org. Any discrepancies between the electronic version or

any information and the printed version that is available from the originating office will be decided in favor of the printed version."

\*\*Please change the Branch Page to say your branch and the Event Stewards Email to be correct.

- As your pages have the regional Deputy already as an Admin they can be notified to add the Kingdom and/or Principality page.
- The Regional Deputy will add Kingdom SMO or the Kingdom Page as Co-Host. (Some events have allowed the page to be added and KSMO can approve, others require the KSMO added so I can add the Page)
- Branches can also add the Event Steward as Co-Host so they can edit the event as needed.
- Turning off messages to the Event is preferred as messages will not always go to the Branch page.

**TO RECAP** what the Seneschal or SMO needs to:

1. Make the Event AFTER the event goes on the Calendar
2. Name Event "Event + Branch"
3. Add Disclaimer, Time, and place
4. Make Event Steward Co-Host

- Budget \$2,415, Expenses \$2,368; revenue \$4,555 attendance 214 w/ 15 comped, 7 sr. discount, 2 students. 16 under 18 31 NMR received
- Profit \$2,186.09 (w/ estimated gain on US exchange). Under budget on everything except misc. expenses.
- Excellent feedback. Site worked well despite a few issues. Caretaker onsite was a real bonus. Site staff was nice to work with. Will follow up to see whether there was any lost and found. The parking was better than anticipated. Should add this site as our list of go-to places for 150person plus range. heavy carpet under the stage might facilitate indoor fighting. Rapier was great and youth rapier. Lots of positive feedback on children's corner. 1-day schedule is difficult—hard to find real estate for 200+ people event in Lions Gate. 2-day is better. Some issues contacting Tir Righ officers, which is a problem.
- Nice to see dance going, though it was moved earlier in the day. People had fun and it adds to the ambience. Gate worked smoothly and effectively.

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## CONTINUED BUSINESS

### EVENTS FOR 2020

#### Canterbury Fayre (Mar 21) - Contract signed, insurance ordered

- West Langley Hall. Will get float next month but needs a cheque for the balance of the amount due (due March 4). No entrants so far. Need to get championship entrants. Due date is end of February. (A&S and Bardic). Can't do site layout until team knows requirements.
- Looking at workshops rather than formal TUTR.

#### Sealion War (May 22) – Cassandra. Revised bid expected

- Had site walkthrough; is a working cattle farm, but looks usable. Will need to get biffies and only one hose on site. Cassandra and Caemgen to discuss numbers etc. Will send in EIF to get on calendar.
- Request for Caemgen to post on FB forum when an event's been awarded.

#### LG Champions (May 30) – Warner Loat Park. City contract coming

- Booked in for date. Burnaby paperwork will take time.

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### **Lion's War (Aug 1)**

- Some work done on coordinating the use of an old site (TBD). Also looking at alternate sites. No price point required but has to charge NMR and has to be a profit. Also dealing with 25-year Quad War and 40-year Clinton War anniversary.
- Tabled until next month.

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### **Trials (Aug 14)**

- No bid for Trials yet, but Briana and Malys are looking for sites.

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### **Baronial Banquet (Oct 24) - site needed**

- Date locked in. Two teams have been going to Briana for guidance and one team has contacted Caemgen and a bid is pending.
- Customary states that if multiple bids are received and approved by the financial team, the B&B can decide which to choose.

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### **Baroness' Tourney (Nov 21) - Site/date needed**

- Cloverdale Fairgrounds is booked the weekend of Nov. 21. Can continue with Nov. 21 date, but no site. Possible site for the 28<sup>th</sup>; Caemgen will contact Hartwood to coordinate dates.
- If anyone knows a site we could use, let Caemgen. Briana has a line on a potential site.

Baroness: The particular location can be a challenge.

**HOSPITALITY POINT:** Definitely finding the Hospitality Station a working idea: we do need to give some thought to placement, depending on the sites.
