Lists would like to report on the results of the many tournaments held at Baroness Inspiration on November 16 at Shannon Hall.

There were 31 uncollared rapier fighters and ten MODs or Dons in the rapier prize tournament. They fought two thirty minute rounds and most wins advanced. The five finalists were Cailean, Davin, Draven, and Gawain and Seamus. Cailean was victorious. Don Guido managed this tournament.

There were 57 unbelted heavy fighters and more than 12 knights who fought in the heavy prize tournament. They fought in four erics in a single round robin and the top two from each eric advanced. Tyrfingr was victorious over Antoine in the finals. Sir Oak managed this tournament.

There were 11 entrants in the Steel Rose, single round robin with no finals, and the victor was Boreaus with ten wins, followed by Gemma and Anezka tied for second with nine wins. Magdalena managed this tournament.
