Section 3.8.1.3. Added "on the Baronial website" for publication timeline of Baronial Council minutes.

Section 5.4 – added "the Games Champion, the Cut and Thrust Champion," to the list of Champions.

Section 5.5 changed "King & Queen" to "Tir Righ Coronet or An Tir Crown".

Section 5.5.3 changed "event fees for specific Baronial events" to "event site fees for Baronial events".

Section 6.7 added "with receipts" for clarification to "The person(s) who transport the pavilion may be reimbursed for their fuel costs, according to the Financial Policy".

Section 7.1 added "from the Baronial website" to "Bid must be submitted using the approved Bid Form by email to the members of the Financial Committee."

- Mistress Caitrin ni Cingheadh detailed the delicious chocolate dessert competition. Eight phenomenal entries made the decision difficult for the judges.
