First Contact Fayre - April 5, 2025 Caemgen event steward, Sorcha co-steward

Post-event report for First Contact Fayre:

Total attendance 114 humans, of which 111 were paying, 8 were comped, 3 were youth, and 13 were non-members. Profit estimate is \$548.55 which includes the refund for one site hour.

I am grateful for Tina/Millicent running the A&S judging team with Etan, and Sara la Rosa running the Bardic judging team. Kathleen and Uilliam ran the games tables in the library all day, teaching teenagers and newcomers (Uilliam even came with handouts of rules!) Mikhail did an excellent job running the games championship, even taking time to teach spectators how to throw his period wooden darts, hauling all the supplies and cleaning up. A huge team of humans carried chairs from the gym after court to restore the classrooms we borrowed from.

I am especially grateful for the patience and good cheer of the thirty or so folks who came for 8 am to help set up and who kept us company for a little over an hour while Kevin figured out how to get someone to come unlock the school.

I hope our seneschal can get some rental money back for their error in not booking a security guard to open up for our contract time.

Court set up and take down was a huge team of people fetching and carrying as well as organizing. My apologies to that team for not knowing where Kevin had planned the away/ready room.

Sorcha

Caemgen also reports that we managed to finish things on time, despite not being able to access the site at 8 am. Three items for lost and found will be photographed – a ceramic mug, a pennant, and a wicker basket. Some site considerations for the school going forward include an emergency contact for weekend rentals at the school district. There are lots of other Langley sites we could use. We did not end up using all of the spaces we booked for the Fayre, though we did expect/hope for more attendees. We recommend continuing a relationship with the Langley school district for other events or TUTR, or other potential principality or kingdom events.

Jacomina located an emergency contact phone number on the contract, and will work on the refund of the hour's fee.

5. Upcoming events

Agriplex

Agriplex Non-Profit Adult Surrey Rates (estimate):

- Non-operational hourly rates (setup, takedown, overnight): \$79.87+GST
- Operational hourly rate (event hours): \$159.75+GST
- Daily rate (12 hours): \$1,917.00+ GST
- Tables and chairs can be rented at 20% of the rental fee. The 20% fee includes set up and take down of tables, given a floorplan is provide ahead of time.
- Janitorial staff support is charged for 50% of rental run time. Ex. 6-hour rental = 3 hours of janitorial support.
- Refundable security deposit: \$5,000.00
- Security deposits are non-refundable in the event of a cancellation.

Discussion suggested we plug these numbers into an event bid form.
