## a little background on the what and why of dog meat:

As it often was in the early bags of Lions gate, it's all bjorn's fault ( well almost...) (Note: The two human sources aside from the North Wind archives for the History of the Dog Meat Numbers are Bjorn of Havok and Sir Harrold of Warrington. Both were early Lions Gate fighters and both served as Master of Stables for Lions Gate in the early years, first Bjorn, then Harrold and then back to Bjorn. So they have good knowledge of the fighters and fighting in early Lions Gate.)

# **The True Story of the Dog Meat Warriors** (from the 25<sup>th</sup> Anniversary book of Lions Gate) by Bjorn of Havok

It came to pass that our Baron thought we should have a war, and if a thing is to be done it might as well be hopeless, so he challenged what was arguably one of the two best war groups in the West Kingdom. The stories of Golden Rivers against Rieslingshire (Fresno) had been the stuff of legend in my trips to the August Purgatorio tourneys. They had Knights up the yingyan, we had... war gamers. Most of us had years of pushing little lead soldiers around Ping-Pong tables. We may have been short on hitting skill, but we knew all about refused flanks, reserves, and shield walls. Plus what did we have to lose? So we practiced staying together, fighting in multiple ranks, and moving in formation. Then we all loaded in a rented bus and headed off to war. On the way down I was telling a favorite story from Sports Illustrated about a couple of Bridge players who went to a big tournament in Las Vegas and survived to levels far beyond their modest skill on the basis of luck, and not doing anything stupid. As the term used in bridge circles for the players that are not expected to survive the first rounds is "Dog Meat" I suggested the parallel. If we stuck together we probably wouldn't win but we would at least scare some Knights.

The true stories of how we won number in the hundreds. The truth is that we had a Knight -- Sir Edward Zifron, who felt he was close enough to Lions Gate to be a native troop. We had All-Star mercenaries from the West led by Duke Paul and Duke William, and we had troops that moved as obediently steadfastly as any lead soldiers. Dog Meat was no longer a term of derision but a badge to be worn with pride.

PS. The Order of the numbers for the Dog Meat is in theory the order in which we first fought in a tourney. I have the honour to be the first. The next few are a tad sketchy as to the order of who fought at the Monbog New Moon Festival (first official tourney) and the Royal tourney was not preserved. However amongst the first was the person who got me into the society Ilya, who came to be known by many other names. I was told by Duke Paul at that tourney that no lady had to that time fought in a sanctioned tourney so Boverk of Momchillivich was the first woman fighter.

#### From the editor:

Bjorn used the story of the Dog Meat on the Golden Rivers war bus to get the fighters into the concept of working as a team. Team work could ( and did!) win against greater skills.


However, Harrold of Warrington remembers Bjorn telling him the Dog Meat story prior to the war bus to Golden Rivers War. It was on a trip south to Mists to fight at an event an unremembered time before the War. (It was a while ago after all!)

So their timelines overlap a bit. I have gone through the North Wind archives and I think have the order as close as I can to when and what. However, there is no doubt, the two of them are responsible for the Dog Meat numbers.

#### the fighter List

Harrold of Warrington had an idea. What about identifying the order people started fighting in Lions Gate? It was supposed to be a one and done type of idea to list the early fighters. They dug back through North Winds and peoples' memories for the beginning number list, which as Bjorn says, has a few sketchy bits. But then, it turned out to Harrold's surprise, everyone wanted their "official number". And that meant every fighter!

The first list of Lions Gate fighters was published in North Wind #26 March AS 12 (1978) There was no mention of Dog Meat in this list. This was before the Golden Rivers War.



#### the first mention of dog meat in the northwind

North Wind # 28 June, AS 13 (1978). This issue was published just hours before the Golden Rivers War...

"...was printed two hours before most of the company concerned in its production left for the war. I've still got to pack!"

### FROM DOG MEAT 13

The mention of Dog Meat was a letter regarding the handling of a fighter's equipment without permission.

It seems Harrold had taken the story of Dog Meat which Bjorn had told him and applied it to the fighters list.

The fighters of Lions Gate knew about the idea of Dog Meat but it wasn't quite real just yet.

Bjorn successfully motivated the Lions Gate fighters with the Dog Meat story on that Golden Rivers war bus and Lions Gate won the war, with Dog Meat becoming a proud identity for a Lions Gate fighter. That fateful story which caused Lions Gate to focus on a silly shtick group identity for the shield wall fighters regardless of skill levels was now reality in the Barony.

#### However it didn't end there...

The next bit happened when it came about that Harrold needed a new t-shirt to wear under his armour when fighting. So he put it together - sports teams have numbers, fighters need something to wear under their gambisons and Lo - the Dog Meat t-shirts were born.

Early Lions Gate wars were often got to by war bus. The whole army travelled together. All the fighters wore their Dog Meat T-shirts on the war bus. After all, the army that travels together, and fights together, tells war stories together.

Editors note: Harrold does not remember exactly when the Dog Meat T-shirts came about. He thinks it was around the summer of the Golden Rivers war though and the first ones may actually have been made to wear on that war bus. Bjorn had given him the idea of Dog Meat and Harrold ran with it. I joined Lions Gate the fall of that year and Dog Meat T-shirts were in use at fight practices by then, so the timeline fits to the best of my knowledge.

Most Dog Meat t-shirts have vanished over the years from wear and tear under fighting gear (to say nothing of the sweat!) But there was a particular style to them, right down to the slightly plush lettering. The one pictured below belongs to the editor, Elvina. It survived mainly as it had stopped being worn under armour when Elvina changed armour type. (It didn't quite work with the new gear).

The front of a Dog Meat t-shirt says DOG MEAT and the back has the fighters name and number.





## the dog meat number badges

One more thing that came about was being given your Dog Meat number on a needle worked badge made by Baroness Amanda. She created the badges over the years and Lions Gate fighters proudly wore them.

It made for great "No \*\*\*\*, there I was" story-telling about how each of us started fighting and where and when we got our number. Which of course led to other fighting stories...

#### and that's not all...

War stories around the Bardic fires led to the Bards wanting to be involved. Filk songs were common. They were all over the known world, not just in Lions Gate. Filks are new words to well known tunes so even non-musical fighters could join in the singing. There was everything from "Colourful Bruise" to "Life is A Battered Helm" to a fighters take on "My Favorite Things".

Lions Gate had it's own filks thanks to our wonderful Bards. There was "Nhille's Sword", "The Saxons and the Vikings" (a war story about Harrold of Warrington) and the new one the entire Lions Gate army would sing on the war buses, "We are Dog Meat".

Dog Meat numbers existed and Nikolai wrote a song to inspire the army in time for the Golden Rivers war.

We are Dog Meat is reprinted below from Songs of Wine, Women and War originally printed in June, AS 13 with permission of the author, Nikolai Andreiov.

## page 22 WE ARE DOG MEAT tune: I am Woman We are dog meat yes we are As we stand beside the bar, But we must go off to fight our Baron's war. For we've heard it all before When he was drunk and on the floor. We shouldn't get our Baron drunk again. Oh yes we can fight, but we're not the best by far, We will kill your knights, then you'll know who we are, If we have to we can kill anything, We are strong, we are invincible, we are dog meat! When we line up for our warfare Our huge numbers make it more fair For they cancel out our missing sword finesse, And when you've hacked through our front lines You'll find more standing right behind, When you're tired they will add you to the mess. You had thirteen knights or more, What! They're lying in the gore. We thought that quality would beat out quantity, But when you are out numbered One knight against one hundred, Your knight has gone and walked into the sea!

#### and then...

It didn't stop there. Within just a couple of years war fighting was evolving and the "lights" also wanted numbers. After all, the archers and thrown weapons folk were fighting in Lions Gate wars. Thus Light Dog Meat was born with it own separate number listing.

#### still more...

And then, Baron Gerhard brought out the collector trading card sets. Just like baseball cards, you could collect all the Dog Meat Fighter cards. The cards had the fighter's arms on the front and information about the fighter on the back. Gerhard kept telling us we should collect to learn to identify all the Lions Gate fighters on the war field...

(Now, if only I knew where I put my set!)

Keeping track of Dog Meat numbers over the years became harder as keepers of the lists changed and eventually the tracking was lost and the listing ceased to be updated.

#### 50 120W...

As Baroness Brynja has said, this is about to change!

With the reopening of Dog Meat number listing, the guidelines are slightly different.

In the beginning it was only the heavy fighters who lived in Lions Gate. Due to the expanded range of martial skills over the years, limiting it to heavy fighters is no longer the appropriate way. The separation of the heavies from the lights is no longer relevant and there are even more martial skills defending the Barony.

**All** those with martial skills who fight for Lions Gate are entitled to be issued with and proudly wear their Dog Meat number. Thusly to proudly tell the "No \*\*\*\*, there I was" stories of how they came to be Dog Meat.

#### the old listings

Below are the listings the North Wind has of the Dog Meat and Light Dog Meat numbers. They are long, as a LOT of folk have proudly gone to war for Lions Gate. And just as often, spent many evenings telling war stories with their friends.
